CLOTHING: Please have your child dress for the weather. At the Nature's Classroom, many of the activities are outdoors on grass and dirt paths. Good footwear and protective clothing are a must. Clothing should be appropriate for outdoor activities regardless of the season or weather. Old clothes are highly recommended. Sturdy shoes or hiking boots (closed toe shoes), socks, long pants or jeans, long or short sleeve shirts (you decide), light jacket, sweatshirt, or sweater

Rain gear (poncho/coat, pants, and shoes) if rain is in the forecast

BACKPACK

FOOD: Send your child with a SMALL BACKPACK OR DRAW STRING BACKPACK SO YOU CAN CARRY your SACK LUNCH, TWO SNACKS, DRINK, and WATER BOTTLE. **NO HARD COOLERS.** It is important for your child to eat a good breakfast before the trip. We will NOT stop and eat on the way to the Nature's Classroom. He or she will be very active on the hike and will need the "fuel" to make it until the lunch break. Also, we will NOT stop and eat on the way back to the school.

MEDICAL INFORMATION: You filled out the forms for the field trips and all information has been mailed.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES: iPods, MP3 players, cell phones, games and other devices are not allowed during programming at the Nature's Classroom. Students may bring cameras and take still pictures. If I see texting or playing any app during the programming time, I will take up the electronic. This shows disrespect to those interacting with you.

SOUVENIRS: The Gift Shop at the Nature's Classroom has many small science items, books, and reasonably priced souvenirs if you wish to send your child with additional money, but I do not know if we will have time to shop.
